Dear Taxpayer:

This letter responds to your call on Jan. 22, 2014, about the unpaid balance for the tax periods shown above.

Case Closed - Currently Not Collectable

We determined that you can't pay the money you owe at this time. We temporarily closed your collection case for the tax periods listed above.

However, you still owe \$290,754.58 to the IRS for the tax periods shown above. This amount includes penalty and interest calculated to Feb. 22, 2014. You will receive annual reminder notices, and we will continue to charge penalties and interest until you pay the amount you owe in full. In addition, we'll apply your future federal or state refunds to the amount you owe.

Please send your payments directly to us. Make your checks or money orders payable to the United States Treasury, and be sure to clearly print your name, address, social security or employer identification number, tax year, tax form, and a daytime telephone number on your checks or money orders. We have enclosed an envelope for your convenience.

Because you still owe money, we may re-open your case and resume collection activities in the future if your financial situation improves.

When you don't pay your taxes by the due date, we charge a penalty of 0.5% of the unpaid amount due per month, up to 25% of the amount due. The penalty increases to 1.0% for each month the tax remains unpaid, beginning 10 days after we issue a Notice of Intent to Levy (or seize your assets). We count part of a month as a full month. (Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 6651).
