This is regarding our conversation on June 21, 2013, concerning the unpaid tax for the tax period(s) shown above.

We set up an installment payment plan for the tax period(s) shown above. Your monthly payments will be \$797.00 and are due on the 28th of each month. Your first payment is due on July 28, 2013.

We charge a \$105 user fee to cover the cost of providing installment agreements. The fee will be deducted from your first payment.

Please note that your first payment must be at least \$105 to cover the fee, even though your remaining payments may be for less.

Although you've made arrangements with us to pay your tax on a monthly basis, if you don't pay the entire amount you owe by Sep. 20, 2013 we must file a Notice of Federal Tax Lien to protect the government's interest.

The Notice of Federal Tax Lien is a public notice that the Internal Revenue Service has a lien against your property. This includes property you acquire after we file the lien. The filing of a notice of lien is a matter of public record and may harm your credit rating. We will release the lien when you pay the entire amount you owe.

You have 30 days from the date of this letter to file an appeal.
